Bass [A Bitter](#) brewed by [Marstons \(Marstons plc\)](#) **Burton-on-Trent, Staffordshire, England**
Commonly known as Draught Bass. Contract brewed by Marston for Interbrew UK. 4.4% ABV

Blue Moon Belgian White Ale [A Belgian White \(Witbier\)](#) brewed by [Coors Brewing Company \(MolsonCoors\)](#) **Golden, Colorado USA**
An unfiltered wheat ale spiced in the Belgian tradition for an uncommonly smooth taste. Gold medalist (white beer) at 1995 World Beer Championships, silver medalist (white beer) at 1996 and 1997 World Beer Championships. 171 calories per 12-ounce serving and 5.4% abv.

Buckeye Hoppie [An India Pale Ale \(IPA\)](#) brewed by [Buckeye Brewing Company](#) **Lakewood, Ohio USA**
The Hoppie I.P.A. continues to be the Buckeye Brewing Company's best selling beer. First brewed in the summer of '98, the "Hoppie" has become a Cleveland classic among hop lovers. Reminiscent of ales brewed on the Pacific west coast, the Hoppie I.P.A. is big, rich in malt and chock full of hops. American malts are used in the grain bill, including pale ale, crystal, dextrin malt and torrified wheat. It is hopped five times with a combination of Northern Brewer and Cascade. After fermentation, hops are added "dry" to impart bold hop aroma. 6.8% ABV

Labatt Blue [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Labatt Breweries \(InBev\)](#) **London, Canada**
Fruity character with slightly sweet aftertaste. Light, crisp and delicate in its flavour delivery. 5% ABV

Guinness [A Dry Stout](#) brewed by [St. James's Gate \(Diageo\)](#) **Dublin, Ireland**
"Masked aroma of watery roasted grains." "Closed the door on the college keg parties and showed the way towards beer enlightenment." However, "the legend of the beer exceeds the experience." "Flavor a nice roasty and burnt caramel with a good balance of mild bitterness, but too watery." 4.1 % ABV

Celebrator has a creamy head of tight bubbles contrasting beautifully with its profound dark robe. It is full-bodied and velvety from half a year's aging. Although it is strong, it is not overpowering. There is a wonderful and complex balance between the various malts, the alcohol and the subtle hops. A complex fruitiness of roasted malt and whole hop flowers make Celebrator great as a party drink with friends and family at celebrations. Despite its richness, it has a faintly smoky dryness in the finish. 6.7% ALC

Becks [A Premium Lager](#) brewed by [Brauerei Beck & Co./Becks \(InBev\)](#) **Bremen, Germany**
Our original Beck's is a classic German lager beer with a distinctive full-bodied taste, fresh "hoppy" bouquet, golden color and full rich head. Adding to its complexity is a slightly fruity but firm crispness and a dry, clean finish. 4.8% ABV

Bell's Kalamazoo Stout [A Stout](#) brewed by [Bells Brewery](#) **Kalamazoo, Michigan USA**
This is a full-bodied stout with plenty of roast flavor as well as hints of molasses and chocolate. Ridiculous amounts of black and caramel malts make this stout smooth, creamy, and utterly opaque. 6% ABV

Bitburger Classic Premium Pils [A Classic German Pilsener](#) brewed by [Bitburger Brauerei Th. Simon](#) **Bitburg, Rheinland-Pfalz, Germany**
The classic Bitburger - a mature and most agreeable beer - is brewed with the best of ingredients in the same traditional way it has been for many, many years. The result is delicately tart and pleasantly bitter - with a strong hop taste. 4.8% ALC

Buckeye 76 India Pale Ale [An Imperial/Double IPA](#) brewed by [Buckeye Brewing Company](#) **Lakewood, Ohio USA**
Seventy-Six India Pale Ale is Buckeye's first bottled summer seasonal. This I.P.A. is brewed with all Centennial hops which gives it a citrus character. In addition, sweet orange peel is added at the end of the boil. The grain bill is 100% English pale ale malt. The name is taken from its starting specific gravity of 1.076. Only 1000 bottles are available per year. 7.9% ABV

Buckeye Old Mammoth Stout [A Foreign Stout](#) brewed by [Buckeye Brewing Company](#) **Lakewood, Ohio USA**
"Full bodied and slightly creamy due to an addition of oatmeal. Dry hopped with Challenger hops." 6.8% ABV

Boddington's Pub Ale [A Bitter](#) brewed by [Magor \(Interbrew UK - InBev\)](#) **Caldicot, Gwent, Wales**
Stronger version of Boddington's Bitter. Pasteurised and artificially carbonated. Known as Boddington's Gold in the UK. Also known as Boddington's Export. First brewed in 1994. Creamy head and a golden well balanced body. 4.8% ALC

Bud Light [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc.](#) **St. Louis, Missouri USA**
Bud Light is brewed with a malt and hops ratio different from Budweiser for a distinctively crisp taste with fewer calories. 4.2% ALC

Budwiser [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc.](#) **St. Louis, Missouri USA**
Brewed and sold since 1876, "The King of Beers" is the largest-selling beer in the world. 5% ABV

Carlsberg Lager [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Carlsberg Brewery](#) **Copenhagen, Denmark**
Sold with the green livery all over the world as Carlsberg Lager or Carlsberg Beer. This is sold with a pale gold livery in the UK as Carlsberg Export. The normal green Carlsberg in the UK is the 4% version. 5% ABV

Chimay Bleue (Blue) [A Belgian Strong Ale](#) brewed by [Chimay](#) **Baileux, Belgium**
Chimay Bleu is principally distinguished by its character of a strong beer. This is a beer whose fragrance of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch is especially pleasant. Its flavour, noticed when tasting it, only accentuates the pleasant sensations perceived in the aroma, while revealing a light but pleasant touch of roasted malt. This top fermented Trappist beer, refermented in the bottle, is not pasteurised. 9% ABV

Chimay Triple / Blanche (White) [An Abbey Tripel](#) brewed by [Chimay](#) **Baileux, Belgium**
Chimay Blanche (White), with its typical golden colour, its slightly hazy appearance and its fine head is especially characterised by its aroma which results from an agreeable combination of fresh hops and yeast. The beer's flavour, as sensed in the mouth, comes from the smell of hops: above all it is the fruity notes of muscat and raisins that give this beer a particularly attractive aroma. The aroma complements the touch of bitterness. There is no acidity, but an after-bitterness which melts in the mouth 8% ALC

Corona Extra [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Grupo Modelo \(Corona\)](#) **México DF, Mexico**
Corona Extra is the number-one selling beer in Mexico and the leading export brand from Mexico. This pilsener type beer was first brewed in 1925 by Cervecería Modelo, located in Mexico City. 4.6% ALC

Corsendonks Pater Abbey Brown Ale [An Abbey Dubbel](#) brewed by [Du Bocq](#) **Purnode-Yvoir, Belgium**
Has a very distinctive bouquet: yeasty, fruity and slightly smoky. In palate, it has notes of port, raisins and black chocolate. Editor's note: 7.5% ABV

Corsendonks Agnus Abbey Pale Ale [An Abbey Tripel](#) brewed by [Du Bocq](#) **Purnode-Yvoir, Belgium**
It has a very big head indeed - pour it gently - and a very clean palate, beginning with a dry, lightly citric fruitiness, and finishing with a distinctive and delicate, perfumy, hop character. Very light and fluffy in texture, giving little hint of its strength. 7.5% ABV

Delirium Tremens [Belgian Strong Pale Ale](#) brewed by [Brouwerij Huyghe](#) **Melle, Belgium**
Named after "the shakes." This beer tastes and smells like a good strong lager. Good hops and pale malt qualities. Pale yellow-gold hue. Spicy and lightly fruity aromas follow through on a moderately full-bodied palate with candied palate malt flavors and a dry finish where subtle hop flavors emerge 11.2 oz Bottle. 9.0% abv.

Dogfish Head 90 minute Imperial IPA [An Imperial/Double IPA](#) brewed by [Dogfish Head Brewery](#) **Milton, Delaware USA**
Brandied fruitcake, raisiney, citrusy 9% ABV

Dos Equis XX Amber [An American Dark Lager](#) brewed by [FEMSA](#) **Monterrey/Veracruz-Llave, Mexico**
Dos Equis Amber is a rich, full-bodied Mexican import with a reddish-gold color and is made from the finest ingredients, representing the brand's traditional Mexican heritage. The history of Dos Equis Amber is traced to the development of the popular Oktoberfest-style of Vienna lager originally created during the mid-19th century. 4.7% ABV

Dos Equis XX Special Lager [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [FEMSA](#) **Monterrey/Veracruz-Llave, Mexico**
Dos Equis Special Lager is a refreshing, crisp, golden, lager style beer imported from Mexico. Made with roasted malts, choice hops, a unique strain of yeast and purified water, this distinctive brew is known simply as "Lager" in its homeland. 4.45% abv

Duvel [A Belgian Strong Ale](#) brewed by [Brouwerij Moortgat](#) **Breendonk-Puurs, Belgium**
Four generations of the Moortgat family have brought together Pilsner malts, Bohemian hops, and a unique yeast strain to create this intense, aromatic and beguiling ale. This Belgian favorite is best enjoyed chilled (40 - 50 F) with discerning friends or good-looking strangers. 8.5% ABV

Fosters Lager [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Fosters Brewing \(CUB\)](#) **Southbank, Victoria, Australia**
"A light-coloured lager style, it presents full malt character with a balanced clean hop bitterness. Combined with a slightly hoppy, but yeasty/malty nose, Foster's lager is a full bodied beer with excellent drinkability." 4.9% ABV

Franziskaner Hefe-Weissbier [A German Hefeweizen](#) brewed by [Spaten-Franziskaner-Bräu \(InBev\)](#) Munich, Germany
Deep golden color. Natural cloudiness, with yeast Crispy, refreshing, spicy and fruity. 5% ABV

Fuller Esb Extra Special [A Premium Bitter/ESB](#) brewed by [Fullers](#) London, England
The blend of Pale Ale and Crystal malts in the brew give a **biscuity**, toffee element to the beer. A smooth, mellow bitterness lingers on the palate to give a superbly satisfying finish. 5.9% ABV

Flying Dog Doggie Style Classic Pale Ale [An American Pale Ale](#) brewed by [Flying Dog Brewery](#) Denver, Colorado USA
Dry Hopped with a load of Cascade hops grown in the Pacific Northwest. Doggie Style has enough hop character to satisfy hop-heads, but isn't overpoweringly hoppy. It's brilliant amber-copper color and pleasant malt flavor comes from the addition of Carastan malts. 5.5% ABV

Great Lakes Commodore Perry IPA [An India Pale Ale \(IPA\)](#) brewed by [Great Lakes Brewing Company](#) Cleveland, Ohio USA
Medium bodied and well hopped with dry, fruity aftertaste, this monumental India Pale Ale honors the hero from The War of 1812 who battled the enemy on Lake Erie. 7.5% ABV

Great lakes Conways Irish Ale [An Irish Ale](#) brewed by [Great Lakes Brewing Company](#) Cleveland, Ohio USA
A malty beer with a notable toasty flavor derived from lightly roasted malt. Slight fruit and hop accents add to the overall complexity. Available Mid-January to late March

Great Lakes Dortmund Gold [A Dortmund/Helles](#) brewed by [Great Lakes Brewing Company](#) Cleveland, Ohio USA
This smooth lager strikes a delicate balance between malt and hops in the aroma, palate, finish and body. It has more body and less hops than a Pilsner, and less malt and more hops than a Munich style lager. 5.8% ABV

Great Lakes Eliot Ness [A Vienna](#) brewed by [Great Lakes Brewing Company](#) Cleveland, Ohio USA
Deep Amber red color, with a fragrant malt aroma. Flavorful notes of rich caramelized malt and noble hop flavors harmonize on the palate leading to a crisp clean finish. Named after one of Cleveland's most respected safety directors, who frequented the brewpub's bar during his tenure from 1935-1941 and, according to popular legend, was responsible for the bullet holes still evident today. 6.2% ABV

Grolsch Amber Ale [An Amber Ale](#) brewed by [Grolsche Bierbrouwerij Ned. \(SABMiller\)](#) Boekelo, Netherlands
A smooth, full-bodied beer with a nutty finish. 5.0% ABV

George Killians Irish Red [An American Dark Lager](#) brewed by [Coors Brewing Company \(MolsonCoors\)](#) Golden, Colorado USA
Rich amber color and a thick, creamy head. Introduced into the U.S. in 1981. Gold medalist (amber lager) at 1998 World Beer Cup. 4.9% ABV

Harp Lager [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Dundalk \(Diageo\)](#) Dundalk, County Louth, Ireland
Bright pale golden; fruity nose; crisp and clean, slightly bitter up front, smooth aftertaste. 4.3% ABV

Harpoon Ufo Hefeweizen [A Wheat Ale](#) brewed by [Harpoon Brewery](#) Boston, Massachusetts USA
UFO (Un-Filtered Offering) Hefeweizen is an American style un-filtered wheat beer. Traditionally served with a lemon to complement the citrus taste yielded from the yeast. 5% ABV

Heineken [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Heineken Nederland](#) Zoeterwoude, Netherlands
The best selling import beer in the U.S. A premium lager. 5.0% ABV

Hoegaarden [A Belgian White \(Witbier\)](#) brewed by [Brouwerij Hoegaarden \(InBev\)](#) Hoegaarden, Belgium
Unfiltered Belgian White, flavored with coriander and orange peel, creating a sweet & sour taste. 5% ABV

Hornsby's Draft Cider [A Cider](#) brewed by [Hornsby's Pubdrafts Ltd./E and J Gallo](#) Modesto, California USA
In the traditions of pubs the world over, we bring to you and your friends the most refreshing and satisfying tastes we know. 6% ABV

John Harvard's Hazed & Infused Lager [A California Common](#) formerly brewed by [John Harvards Brewhouse Washington DC](#) Boulder, Co
One of the few beer styles which has U.S. origins, our fine example of a California Common Lager (aka "Steam" beer) is unfiltered and dry-hopped. OG 13.4

Jw Dunde's Original Honey Brown Lager [An American Dark Lager](#) brewed by [High Falls Brewing Company](#) Rochester, New York USA
Deep golden color, and smooth, full-bodied taste with just a hint of honey on the palate. 4.5% ABV

Karlovačko Pivo [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Karlovačka Pivovara \(Heineken\)](#) Karlovac, Croatia
5.4% ABV

Lindemans Framboise [A Lambic - Fruit](#) brewed by [Brouwerij Lindemans](#) St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium
A clean natural tasting brew with undertones of fresh raspberries and a wonderful aroma. 2.5% ABV

Lindemans Peche [A Lambic - Fruit](#) brewed by [Brouwerij Lindemans](#) St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium
A golden peach lambic with a sparkling appearance and fruity taste. 2.5% ABV

Leinenkugels Berry weiss [A Fruit Beer](#) brewed by [Leinenkugel Brewing Company \(SABMiller\)](#) Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin USA
A real warm-weather refresher, Leinenkugels Berry Weiss is brewed from a blend of Pale and Wheat malts and Cluster hops, then sweetened with fresh Wisconsin loganberries, elderberries and blackberries. Available April through September 4.74% ABV

Magic hat #9 [A Fruit Beer](#) brewed by [Magic Hat Brewing Company](#) South Burlington, Vermont USA
A Beer Cloaked in Secrecy An ale whose mysterious and unusual palate will swirl across your tongue and ask more questions than it answers. A beer brewed clandestinely and given a name whose meaning is never revealed. Why #9? Why, indeed. A sort of dry, crisp, fruity, refreshing, not-quite pale ale. #9 is really impossible to describe because there's never been anything else quite like it. Fermented with our 150 year old strain of top-fermenting English yeast. 4.6% ABV

Magic hat circus boy [A Spice/Herb/Vegetable](#) brewed by [Magic Hat Brewing Company](#) South Burlington, Vermont USA
Yes, the bottle calls it a hefeweizen. The beer, however, is brewed with a (fairly hefty) portion of lemongrass, which contributes a significant aroma and flavor. Thus we have deemed it a Spice/herb/vegetable and not a German Hefeweizen, which should be free from adjuncts (other than hops). 5.4% ABV

Mackeson XXX Stout [A Sweet Stout](#) brewed by [Boston Beer Company](#) Boston, Massachusetts USA
4.9% ABV

Michelob Ultra [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc.](#) St. Louis, Missouri USA
Introduced in 1978. Michelob Ultra, the new low-carb light beer with taste smooth enough to carry the Michelob name. 4.2% ABV

Miller High Life [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Miller Brewing Company \(SABMiller\)](#) Milwaukee, Wisconsin USA
Its clean, smooth taste has stood the test of time and represents the finest in American beers. Always smooth, never bitter. 4.7% ABV

Miller Lite [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Miller Brewing Company \(SABMiller\)](#) Milwaukee, Wisconsin USA

Cask version was first brewed in 1979 by Morland Brewery to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the MG car factory in Abingdon. The name comes from the MG factory's works car - the gold speckled MG Featherweight Fabric Saloon, affectionately known as the Ol' Speckl'd 'Un. 5.20% AVB

NEW CASTLE BROWN ALE [A Brown Ale](#) brewed by [Dunston \(Scottish Courage - Scottish & Newcastle\)](#) Gateshead, Tyne & Wear, England
Newcastle Brown Ale was first brewed in 1927 in Newcastle-upon-Tyne, England, by Jim Porter after three years of development. Production moved from Newcastle to Gateshead at the end of 2004. 4.7% ABV

North coast Old Rasputin Russian Imperial Stout [An Imperial Stout](#) brewed by [North Coast Brewing Company](#) Fort Bragg, California USA
A rich, intense brew with a robust palate, a fruity nose and a warming finish. Very complex. 9% ABV

Okocim O.K. Beer [A Premium Lager](#) brewed by [Carlsberg Polska](#) Warszawa, Poland
Okocim beer brewed for Export . 5.6% ABV

Otter Creek Stovepipe Porter [A Porter](#) brewed by [Otter Creek Brewing](#) Middlebury, Vermont USA
This is a traditional porter, made to warm the bones. Nearly black in color, Stovepipe Porter has a rich palate and a roasted, hoppy and slightly herbal aroma. 5.4% ABV

Pacifico Clara [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Grupo Modelo \(Corona\)](#) México DF, Mexico
Pacifico, a pilsener type beer, dates back to the beginning of 1900's. Since 1985, Pacifico has been exported mainly to the West Coast of USA, where it has gained strong recognition. 4.5% ABV

Palma Louca [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Kaiser \(Brazil\) \(MolsonCoors\)](#) Diviaopolis - MG, Brazil
Lager beer from Rio, Brazil, the carnival capital of the world. A typical, refreshing and smooth, Brazilian style lager.

Paulaner Hefeweissbier [A German Hefeweizen](#) brewed by [Paulaner Brauerei \(Schörghuber\)](#) Munich, Germany

Since 2001, contract-brewed for Pabst Brewing (San Antonio), as Pabst no longer owns a brewery of its own. Established in Milwaukee in 1844, this is the original Pabst Blue Ribbon beer. Nature's choicest products provide its prized flavor. Only the finest of hops and grains are used. Selected as America's Best in 1893. 5% ABV

Peroni [A Pale Lager](#) brewed by [Birra Peroni Industriale \(SABMiller\)](#) Roma, Italy
